

Project Punde Kundo is The Red Panda Project's signature program. We use this program to enter into a community and establish a network of forest guardians, whom become our tentacles into the community.

Our forest guardians both monitor and protect red panda habitat as well as educate their communities about the importance of red panda to their future.

Our goal is to create a network of community monitors that are the voice for red panda and their home, the Eastern Himalayan Broadleaf and Conifer Forest.

In 2006, RPP initiated this program in Eastern Nepal and to date, RPP works with 8 community forests, has 16 forest guardians and is in the process of creating the first community forest network.
